Budapest Declaration

- Budapest declaration: addressing issues of low-prevalence countries:
 - treatment and care
 - prevention
 - key populations
 - policies and legislations
 - stigma



Access issues of low-prevalence settings

- antiretroviral treatment
 - stock-outs
 - limited range of ARV
- diagnostics
 - stock-outs of CD4+ and VL tests
- access to treatment and care
 - centralized treatment
 - limited number of doctors and nurses
 - STI/TB screening and care, mental health care services,
- access to health care services
 - discriminating and outdated guidelines (dental care, transplant etc.)
