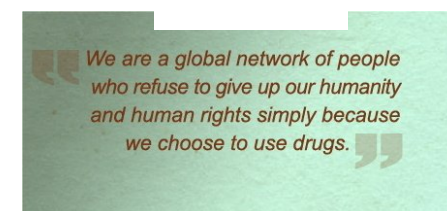

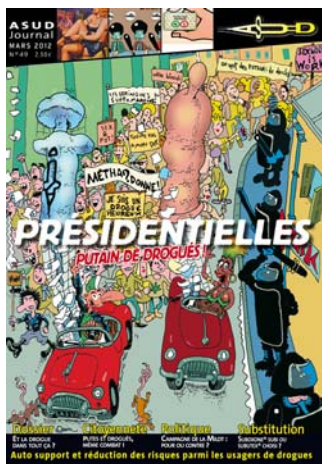

What groups are represented?

People who use heroin and other opiates	100%
People who inject drugs	100%
People who receive prescribed substitutes for their drug of choice	100%
People who use cocaine	78.6%
People who use crack, methamphetamines and amphetamine	71.4%
People who use party drugs	50%
People who use cannabis	35.7%

Activist group	85.7%
Lobby group	71.4%
Patient interest group	57.1%
Service provider	57.1%
Other	35.7%

Services on offer

Advice on safe drug use/harm reduction advice	85.7%
Training	71.4%
Syringe patrol and distribution	64.3%
Help with treatment	64.3%
Wound care and basic health care	57.1%
Legal aid	50%
Food provision	42.9%
Housing advice	35.7%
Nursing	21.4%

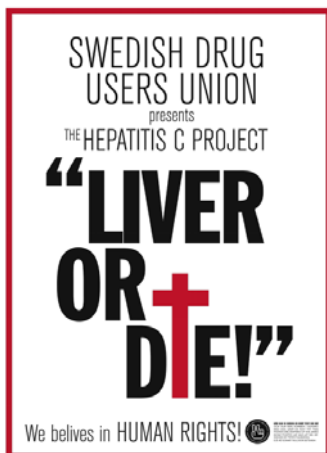
