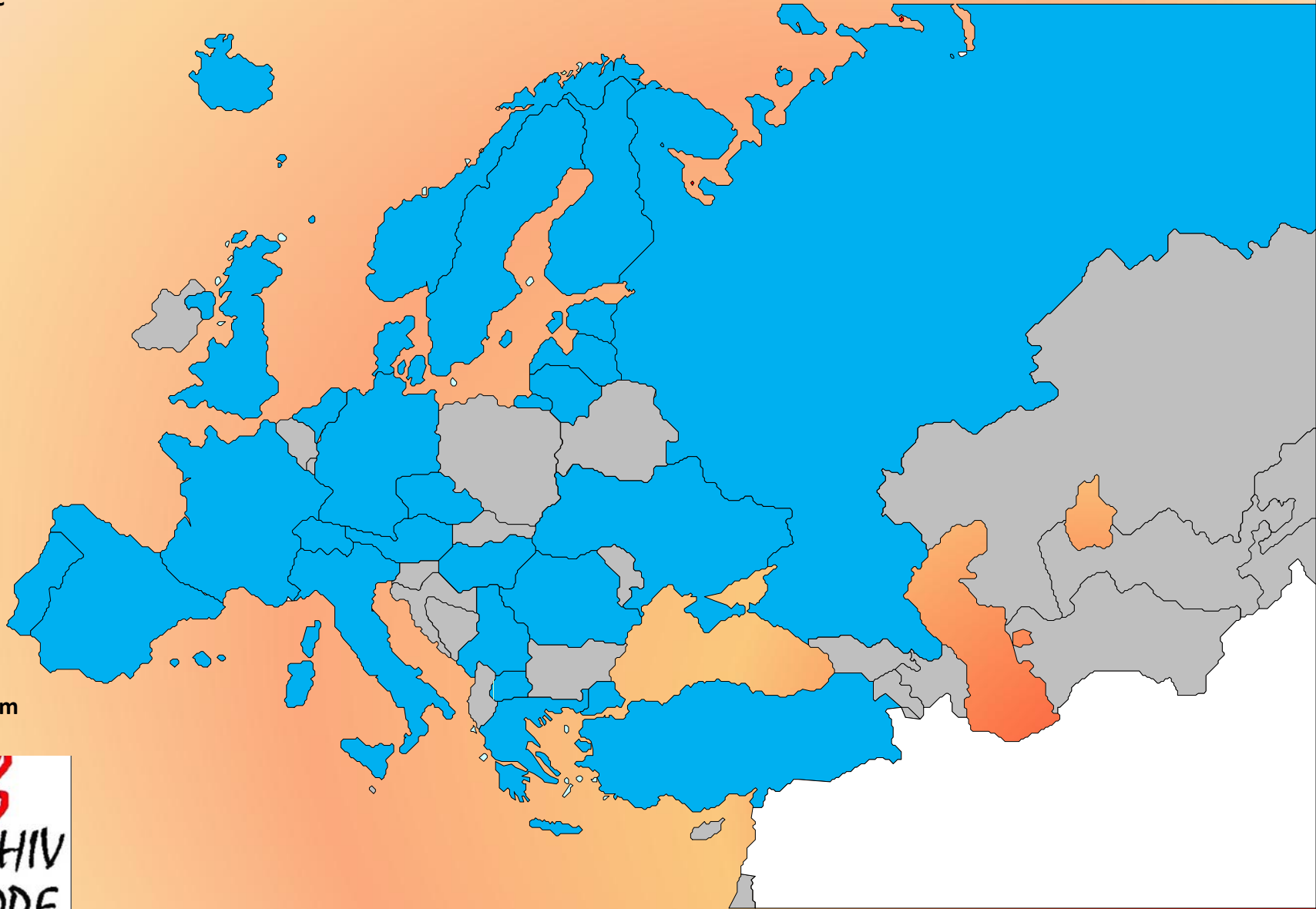


- The mapping where done in both Russian and English

- 1 respondent was taken out of the survey, due to quality of response.

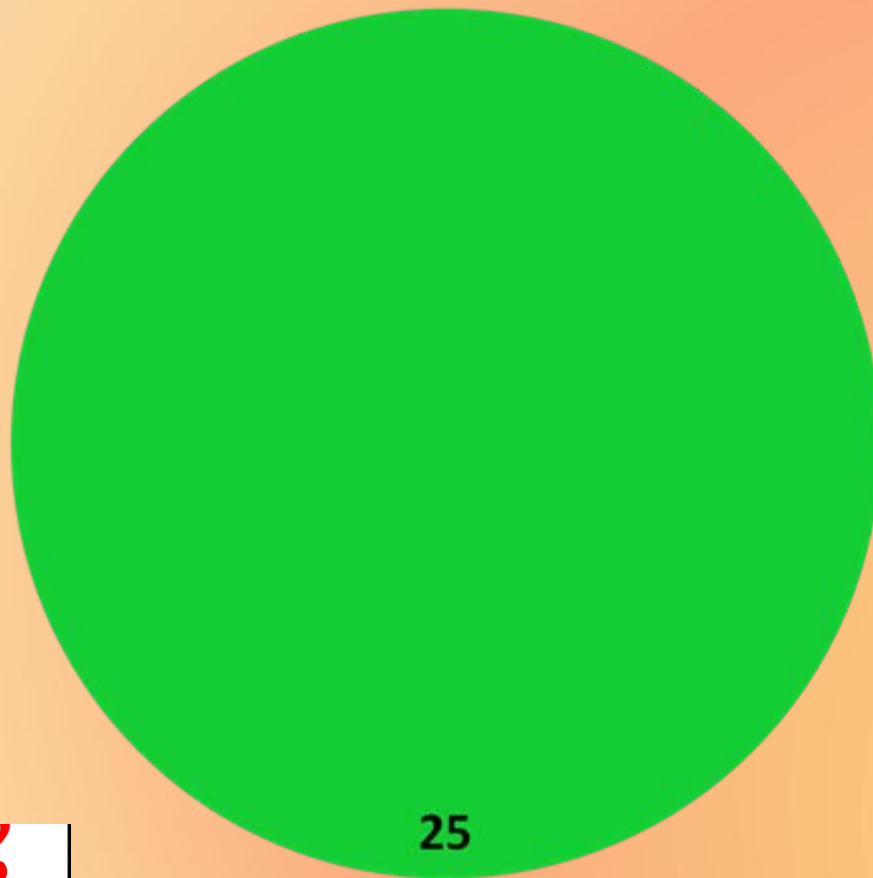

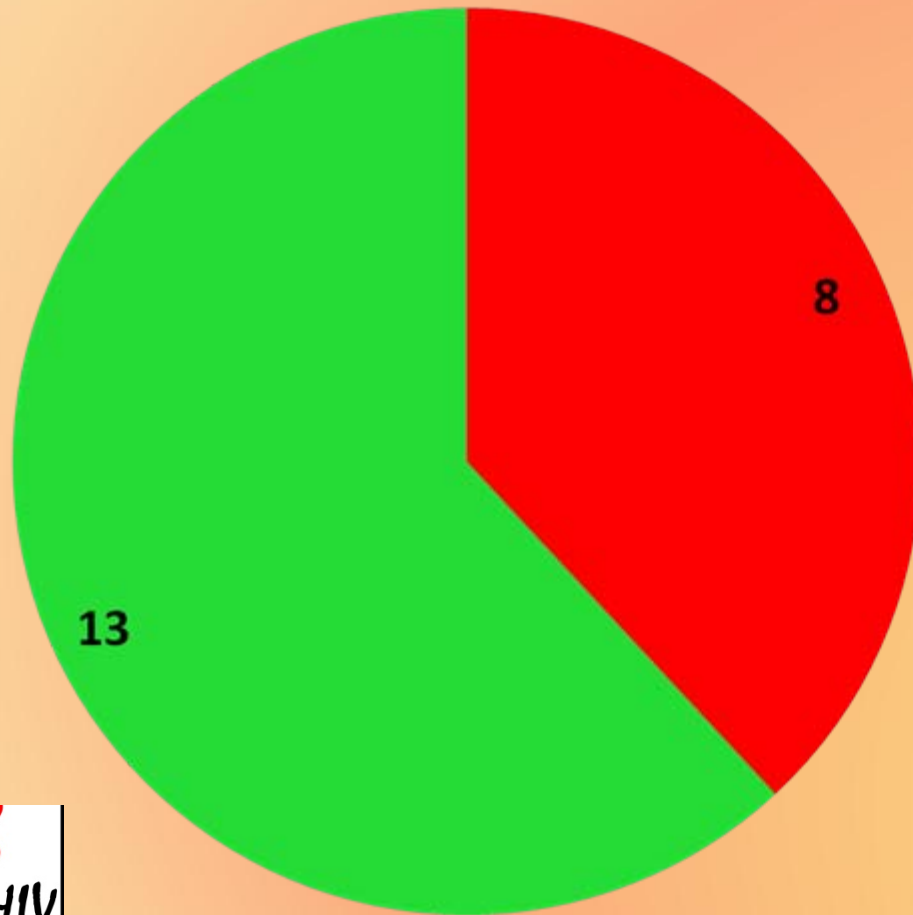

A 2 A - Do pregnant women who have HIV, in your country get to choose themselves between c-section and natural delivery?



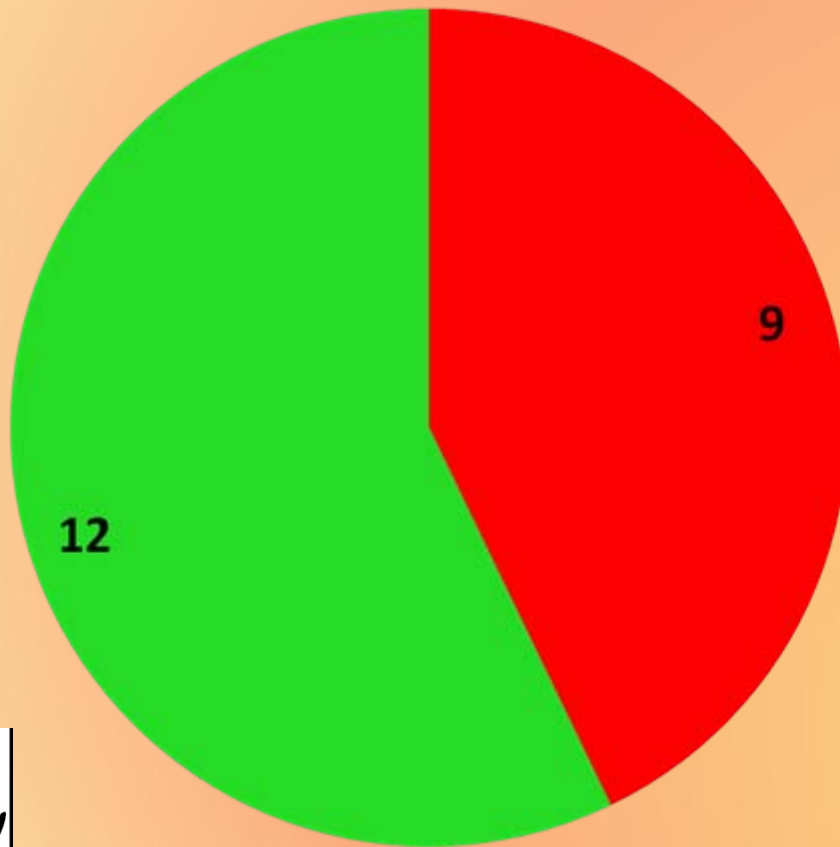

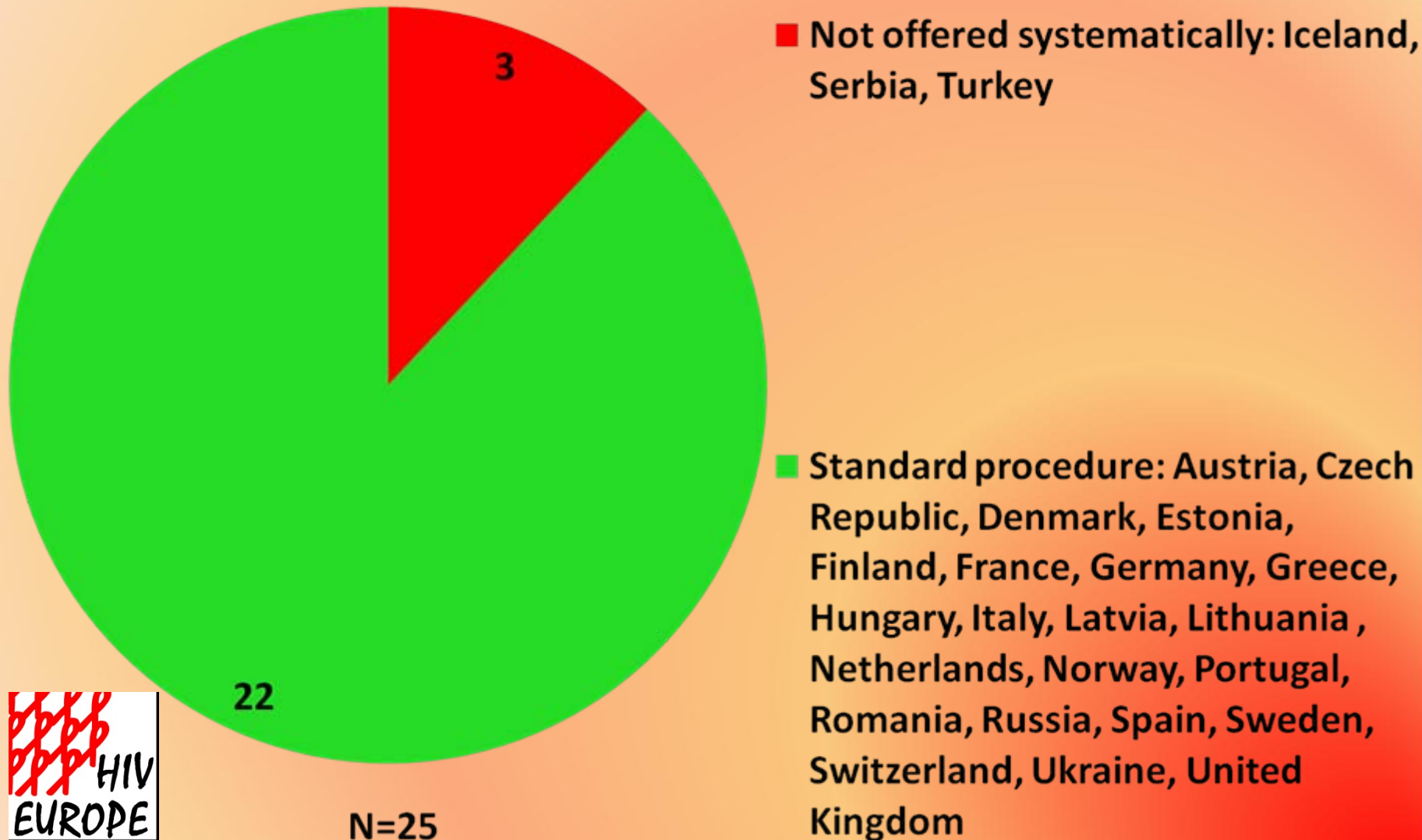

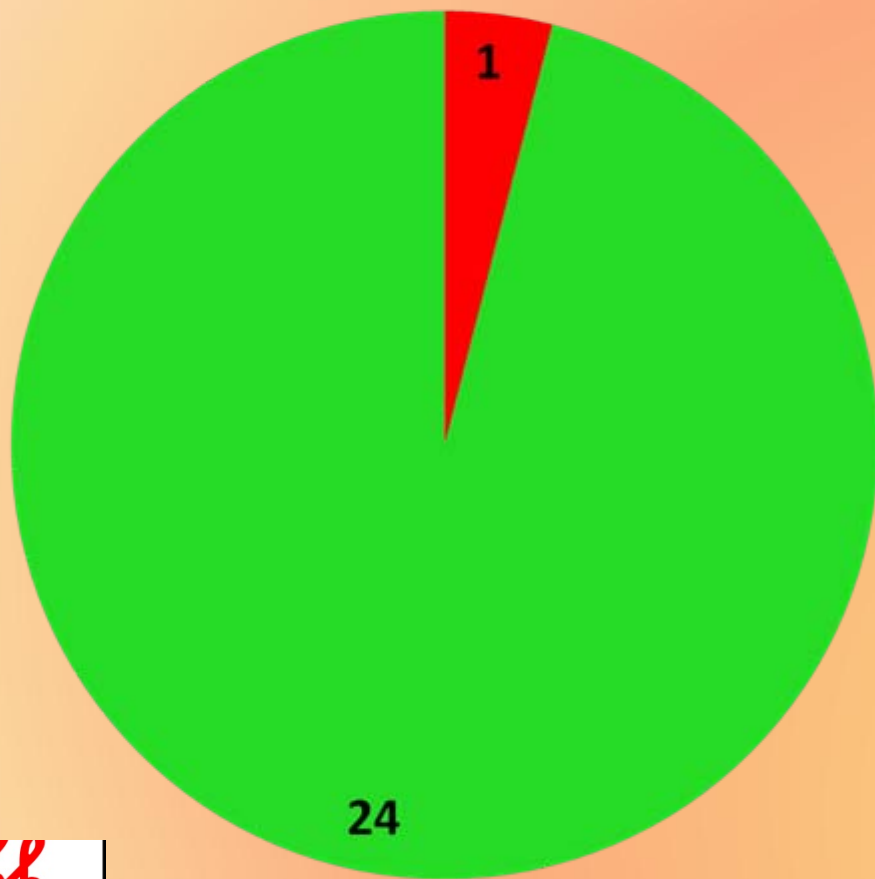

A 4 A - Are women with HIV in your country given counselling on infant feeding procedures when they give birth to a child?



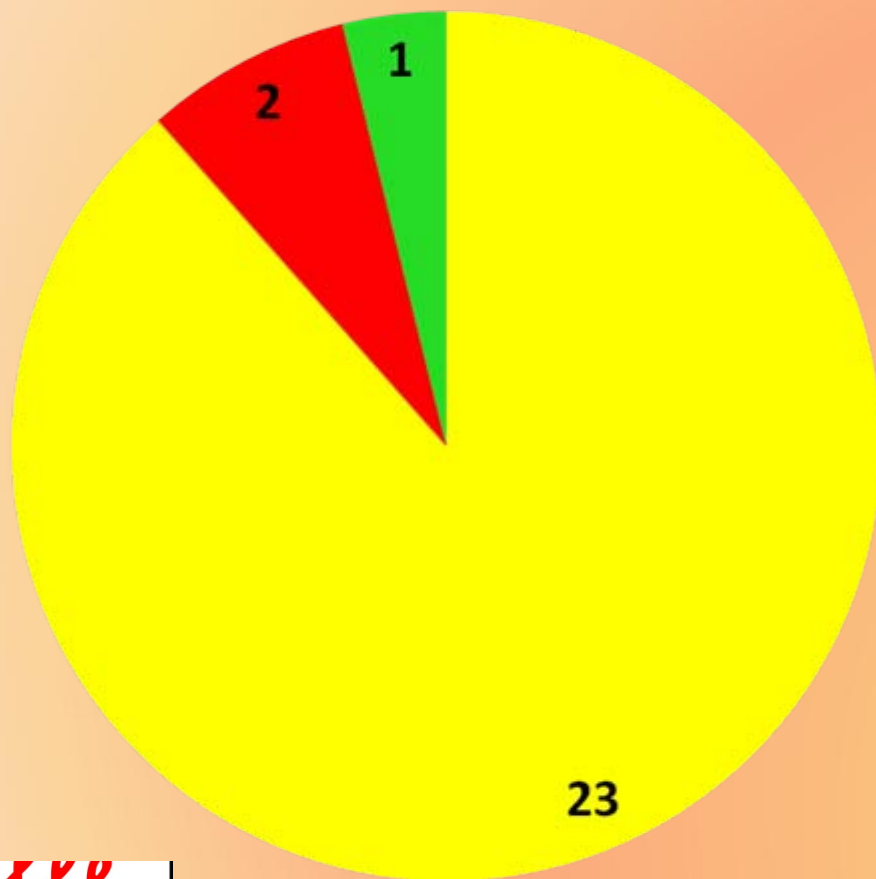

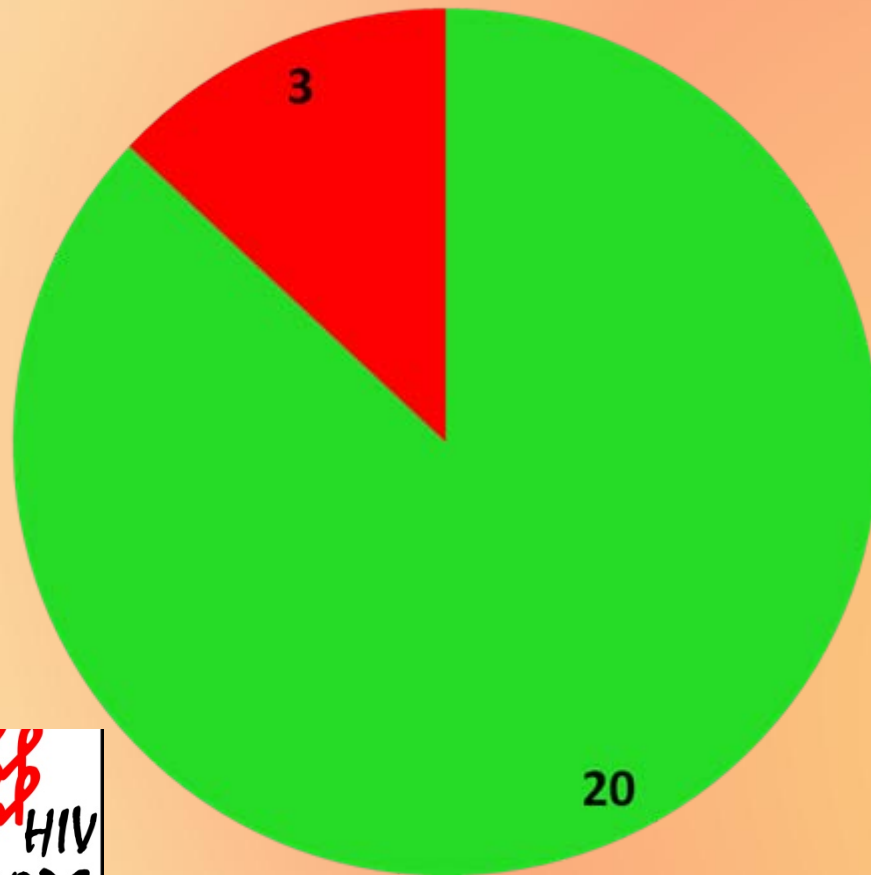

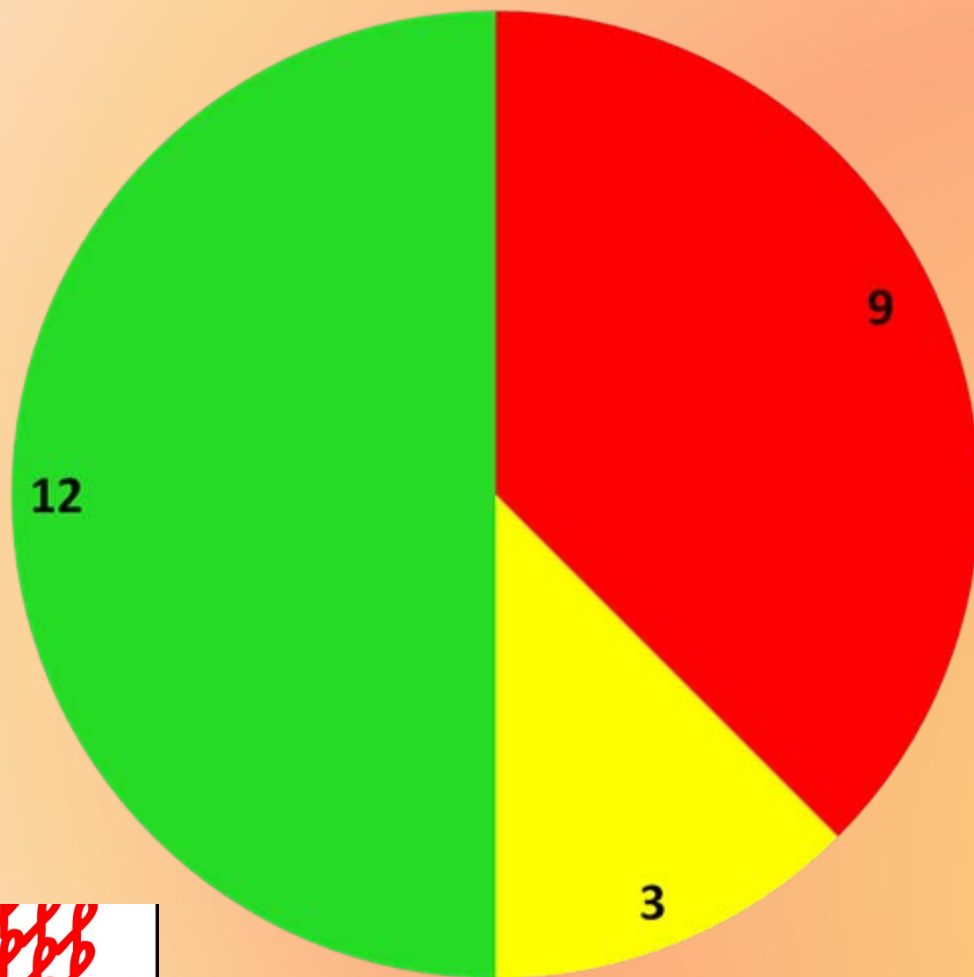

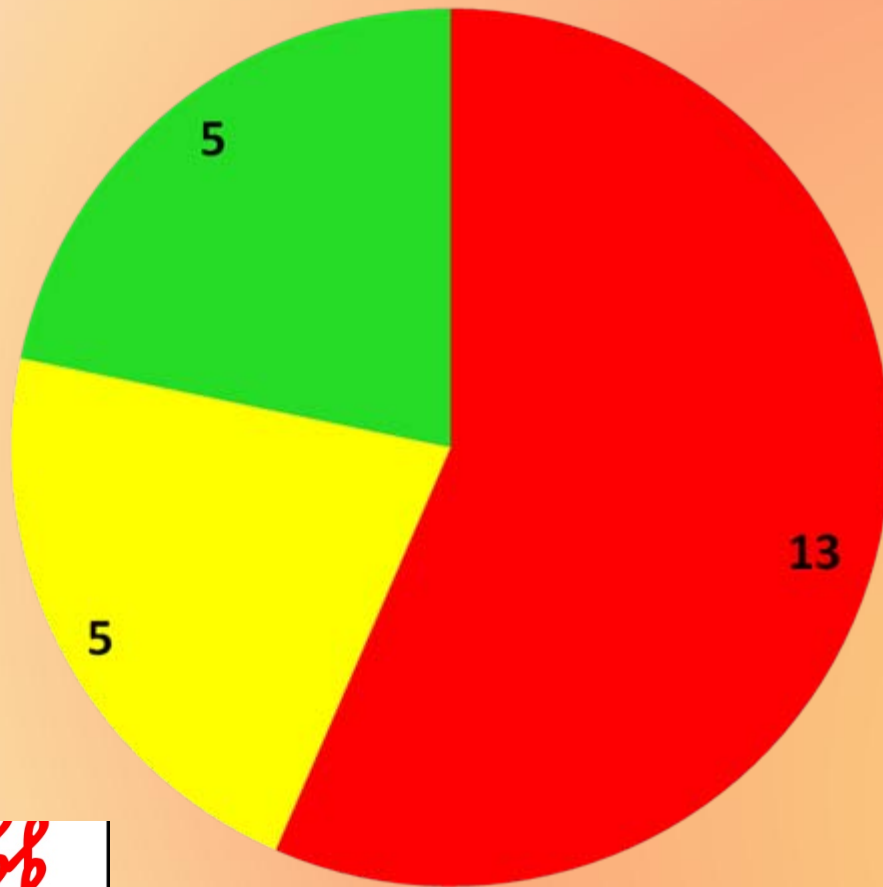

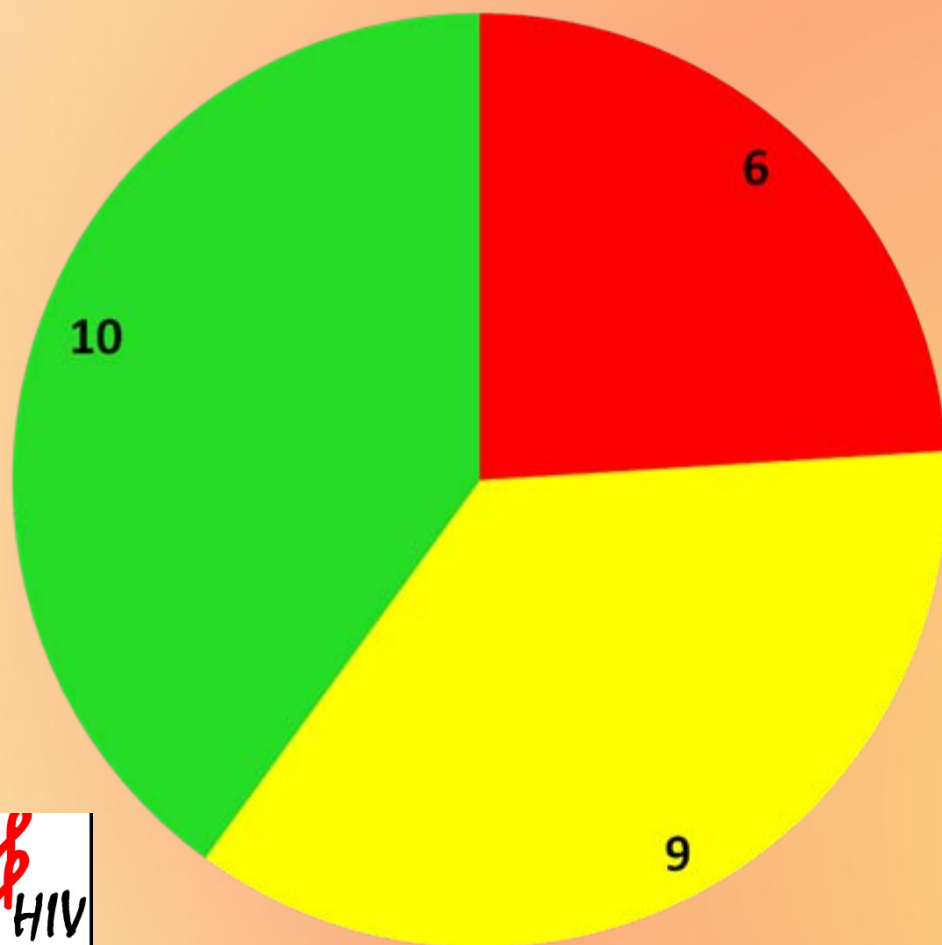

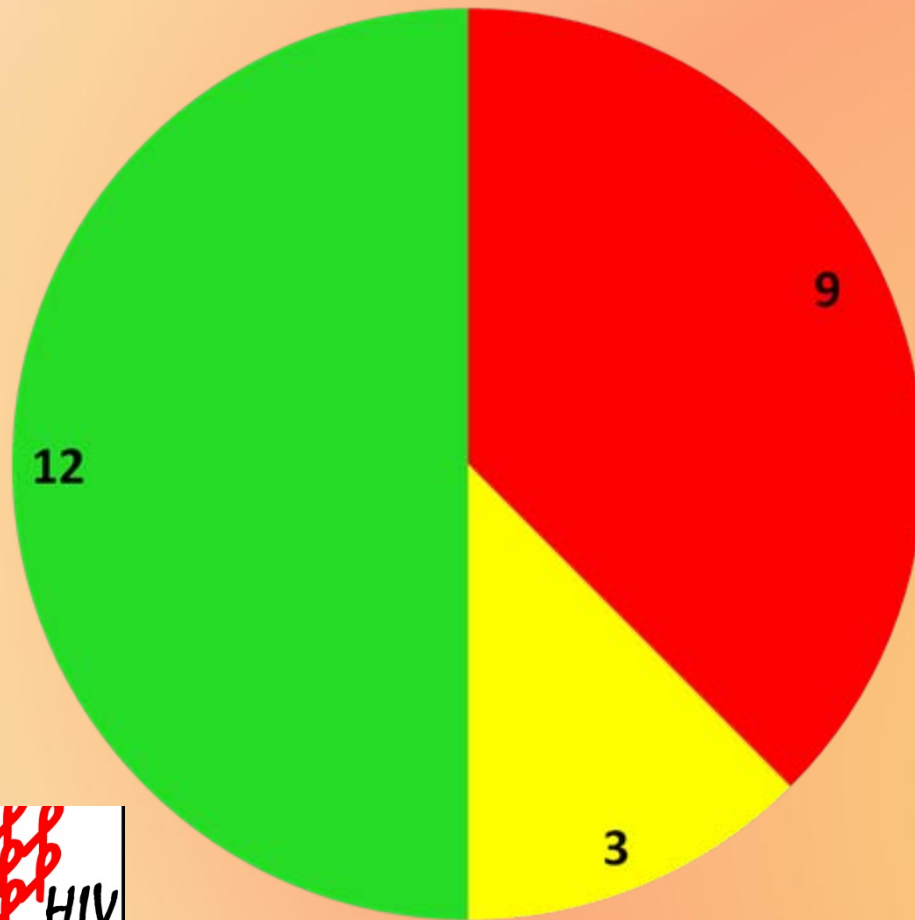

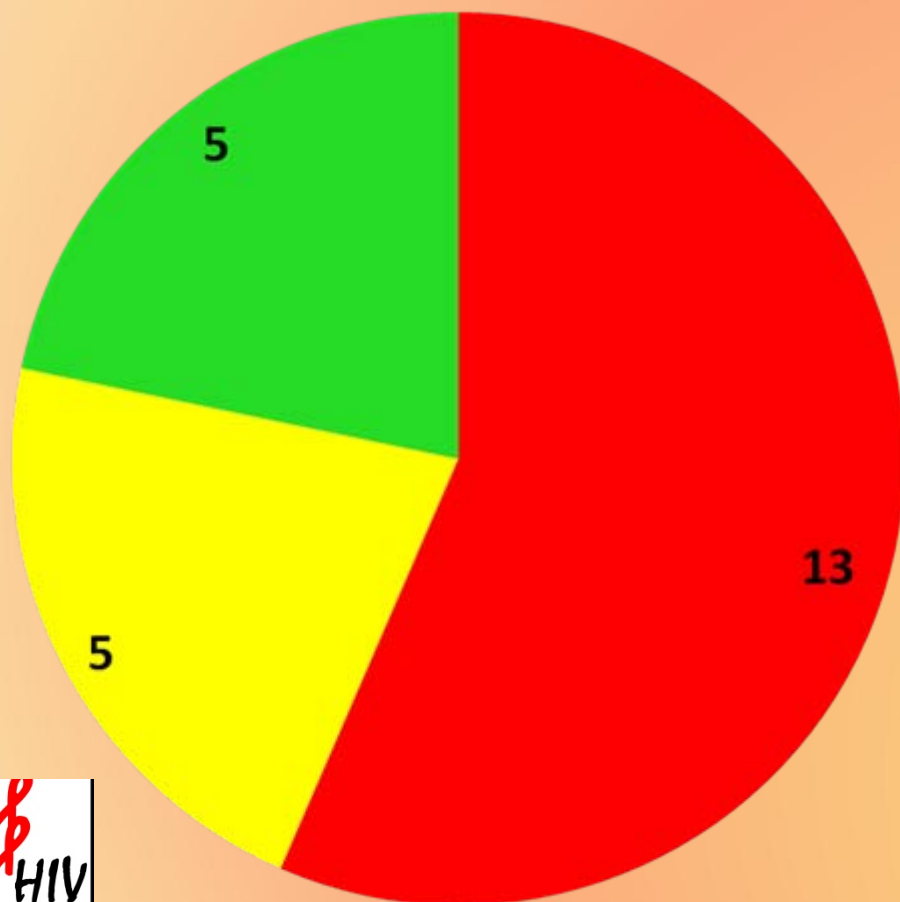

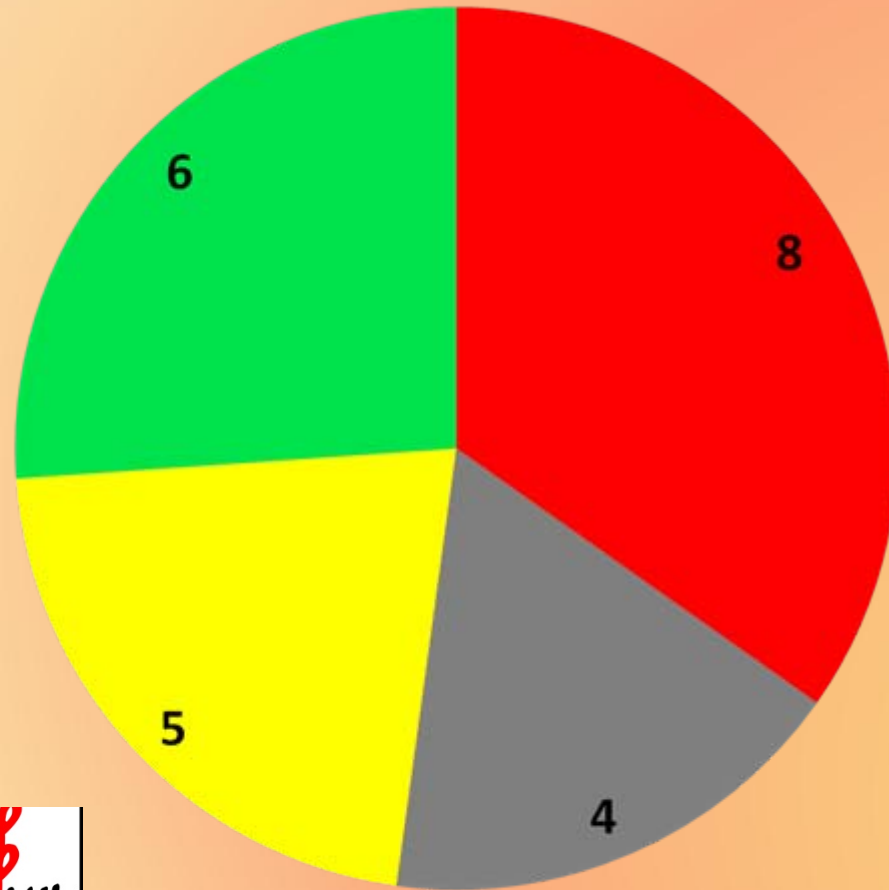

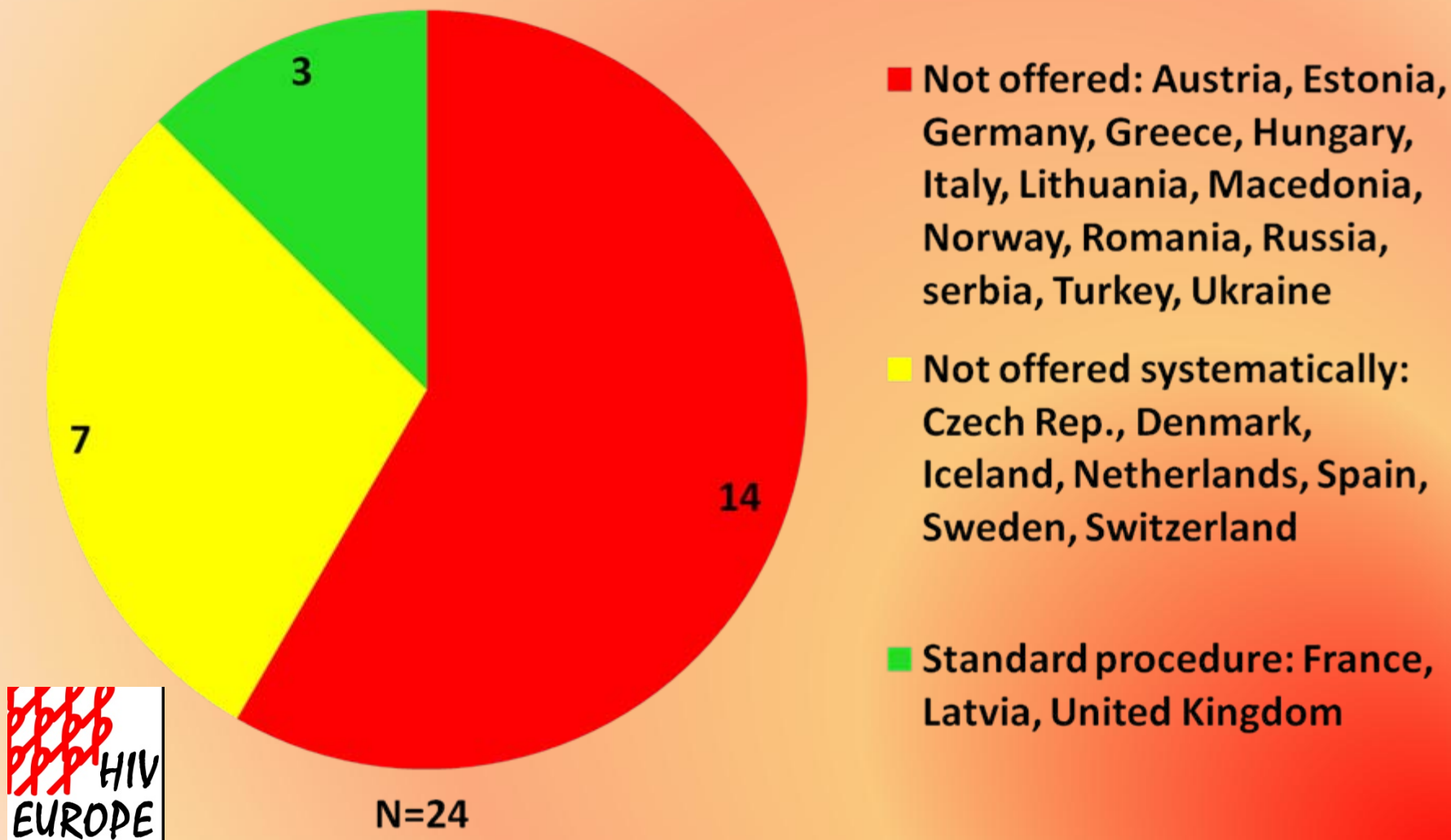

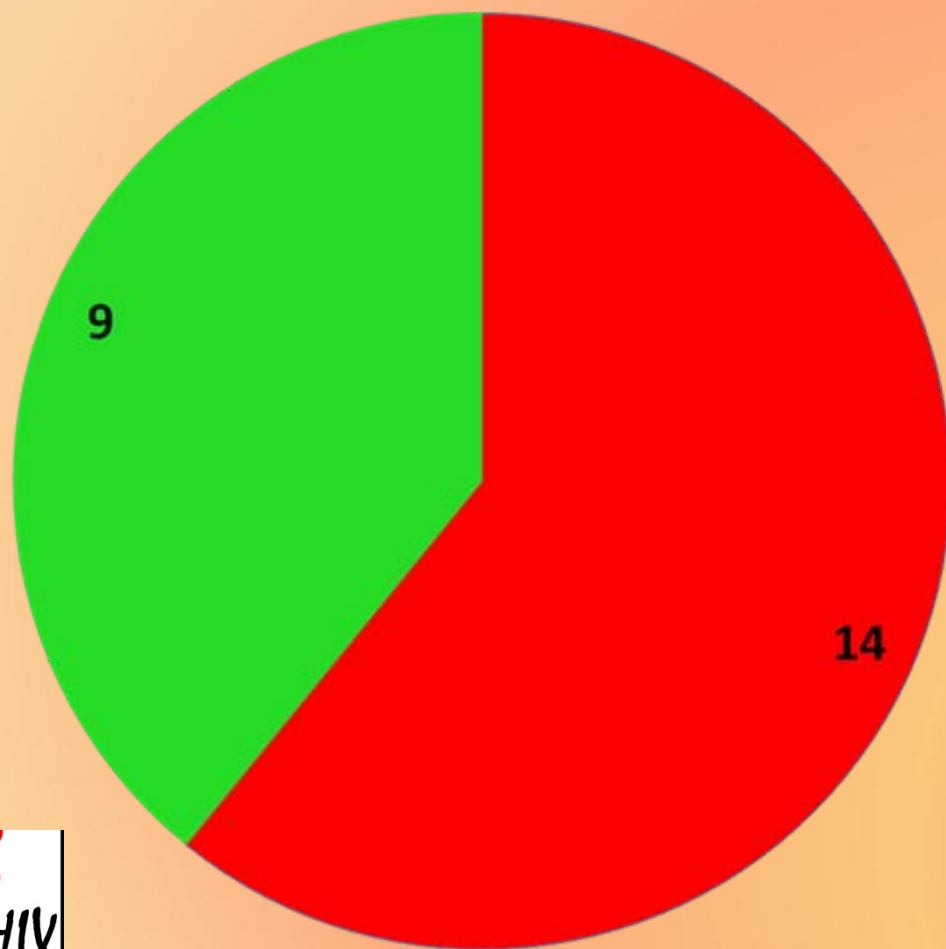

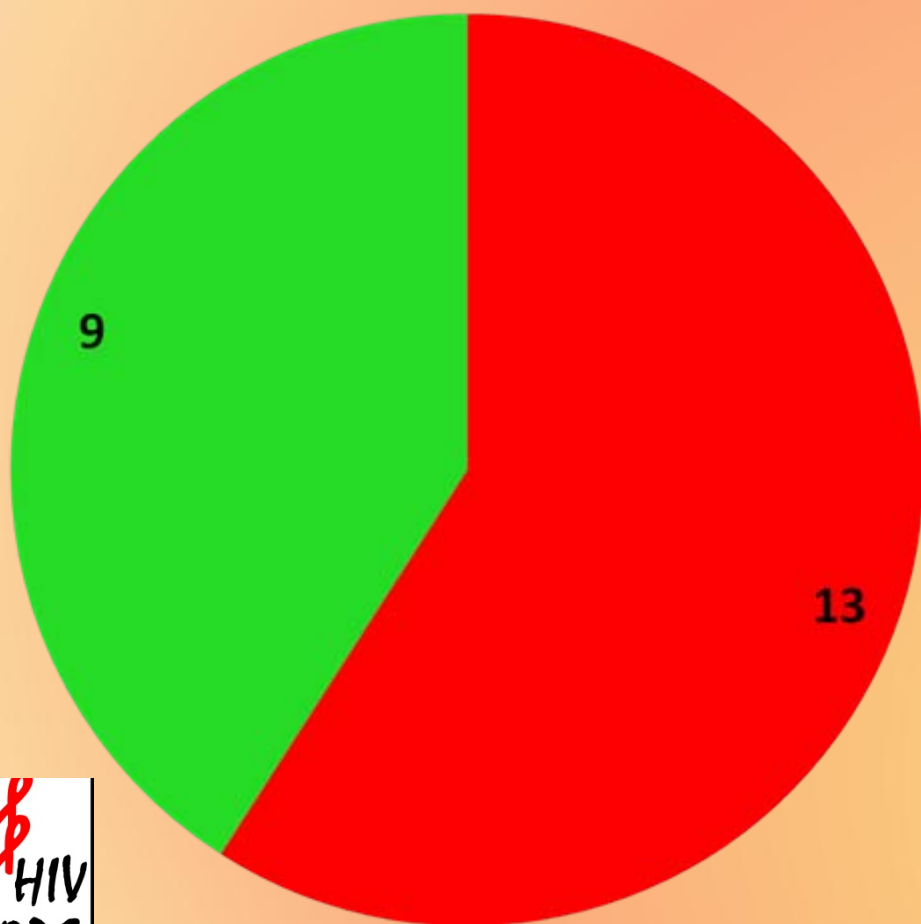

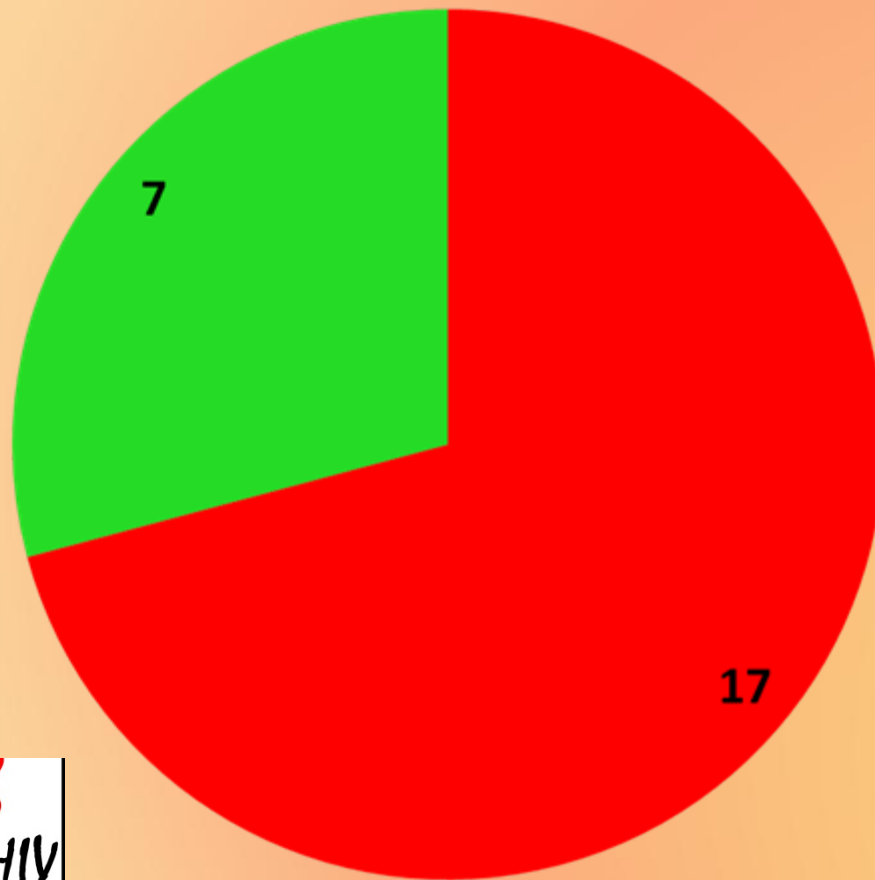

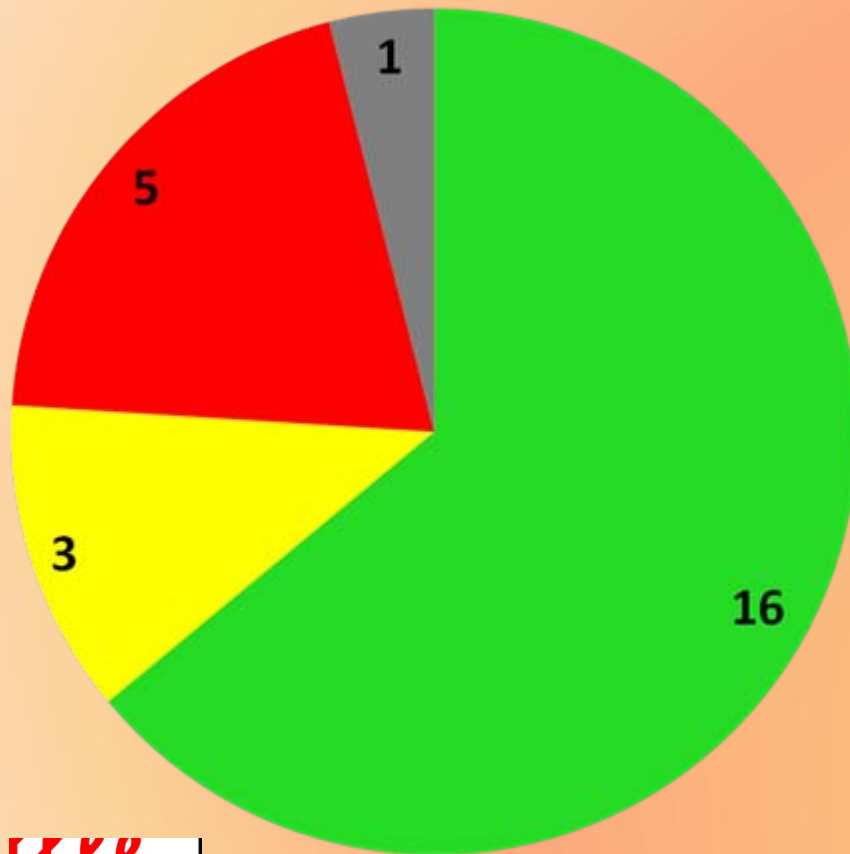

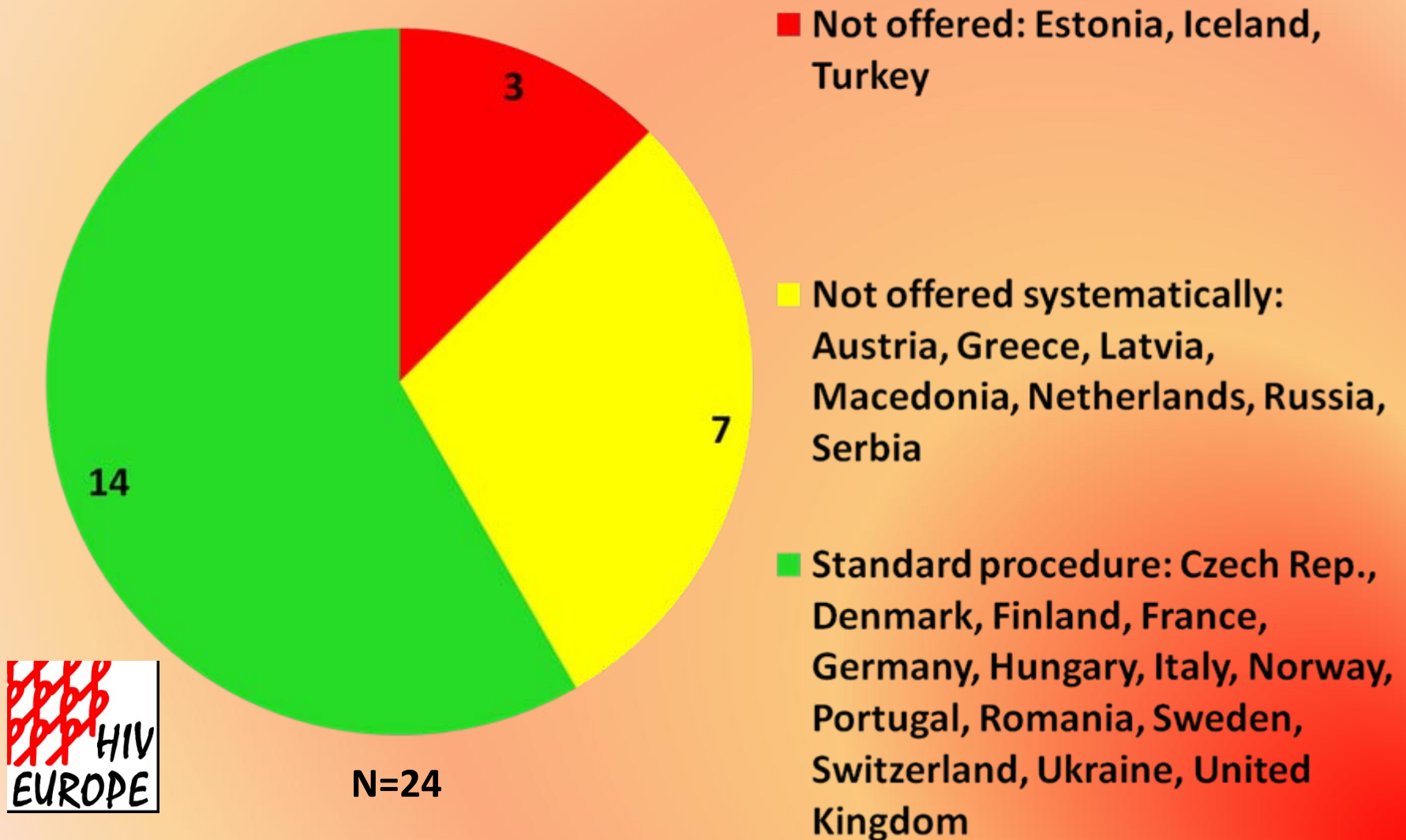

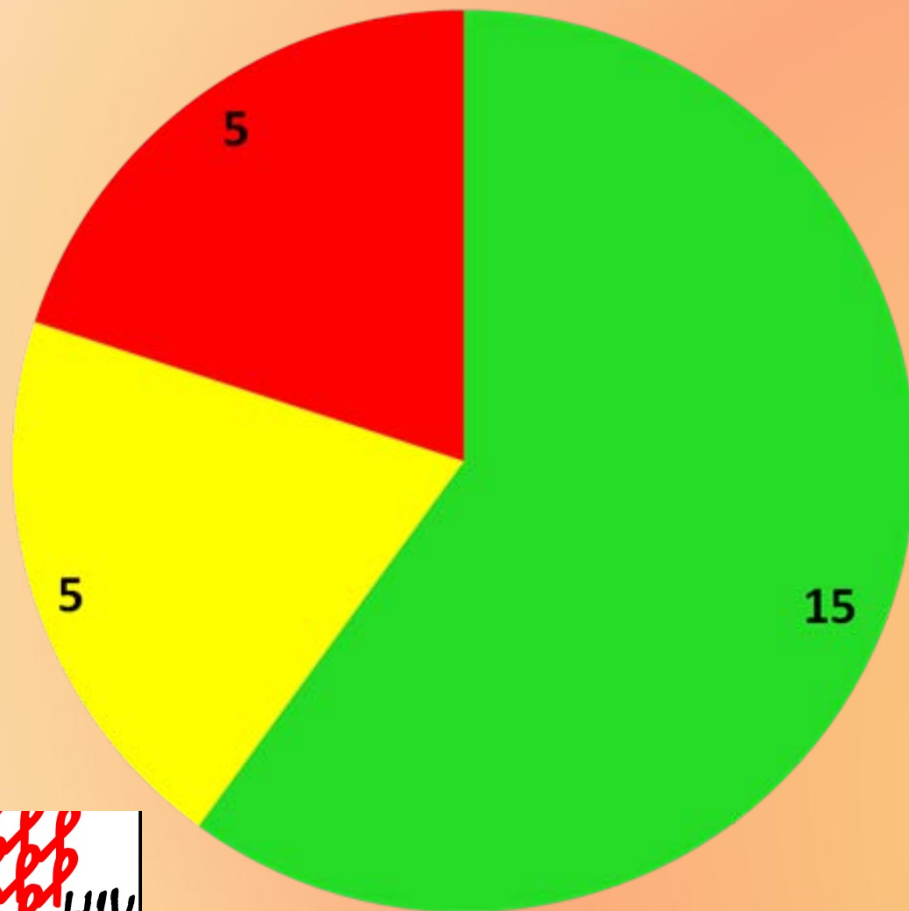


H 1 - If a woman (without HIV) in your country wishes to terminate her pregnancy, is she offered an abortion legally and performed by the health system?

H 3 - In your country, does the health system or other authority pressure women with HIV to have an abortion?

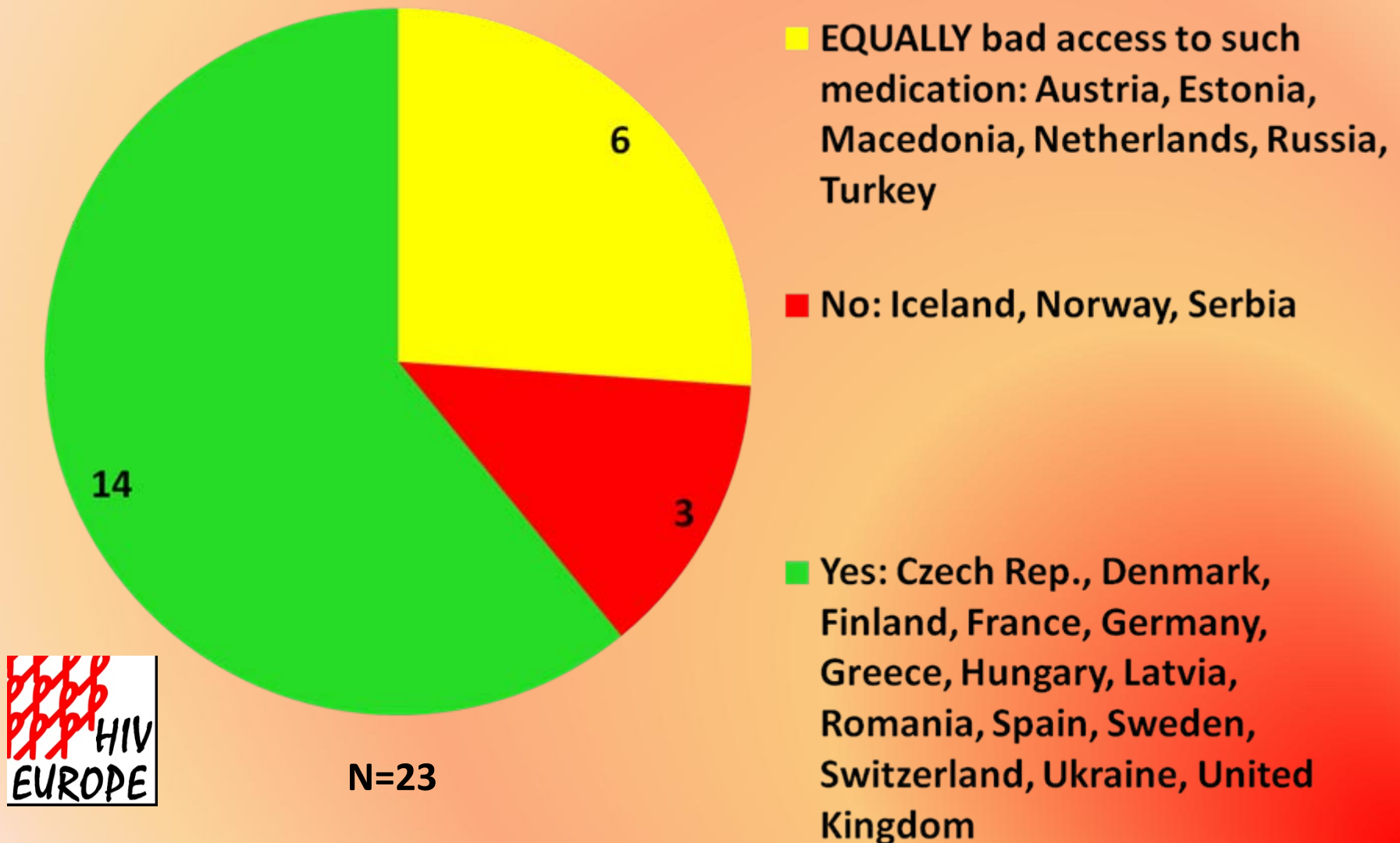

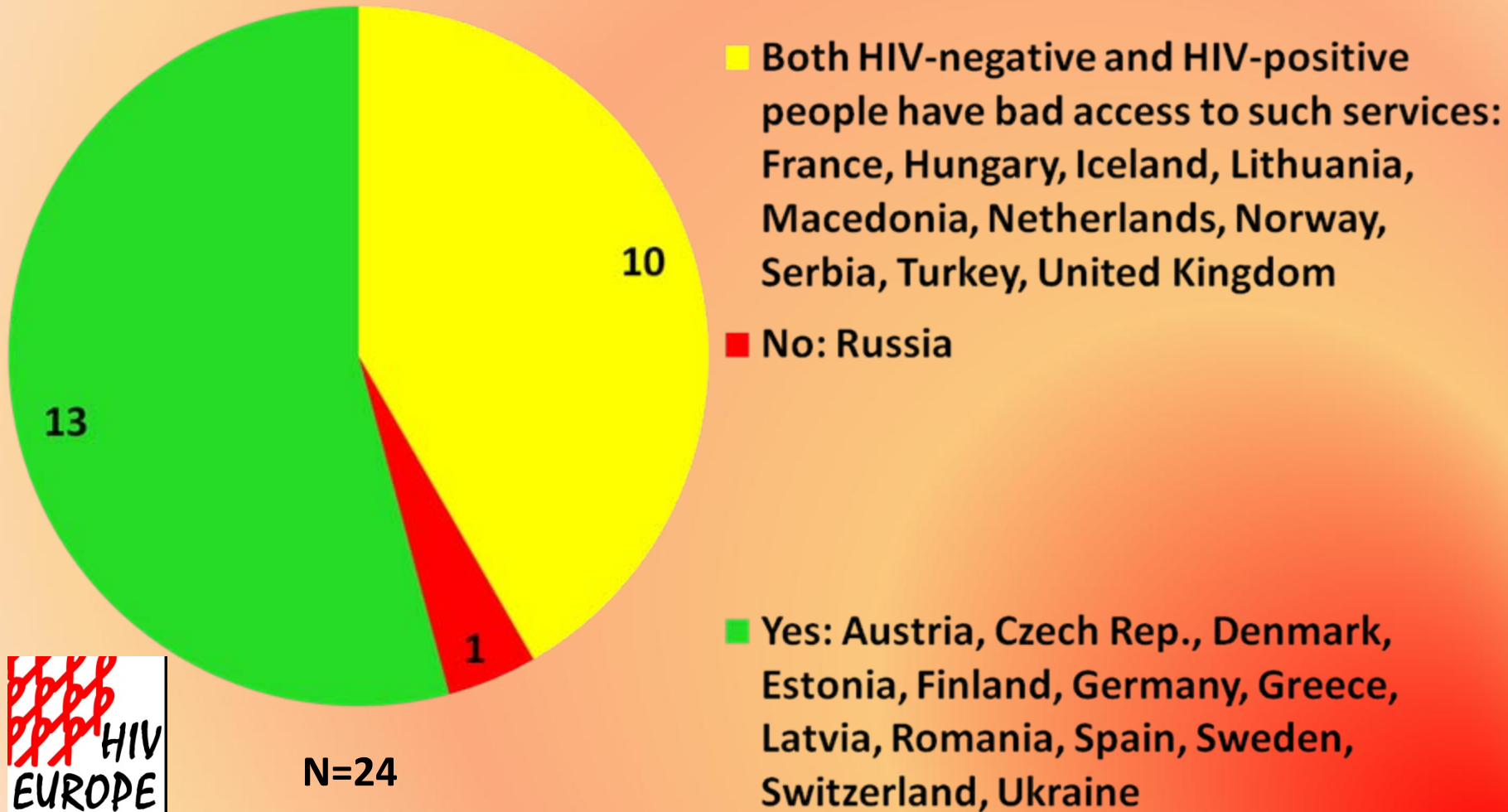

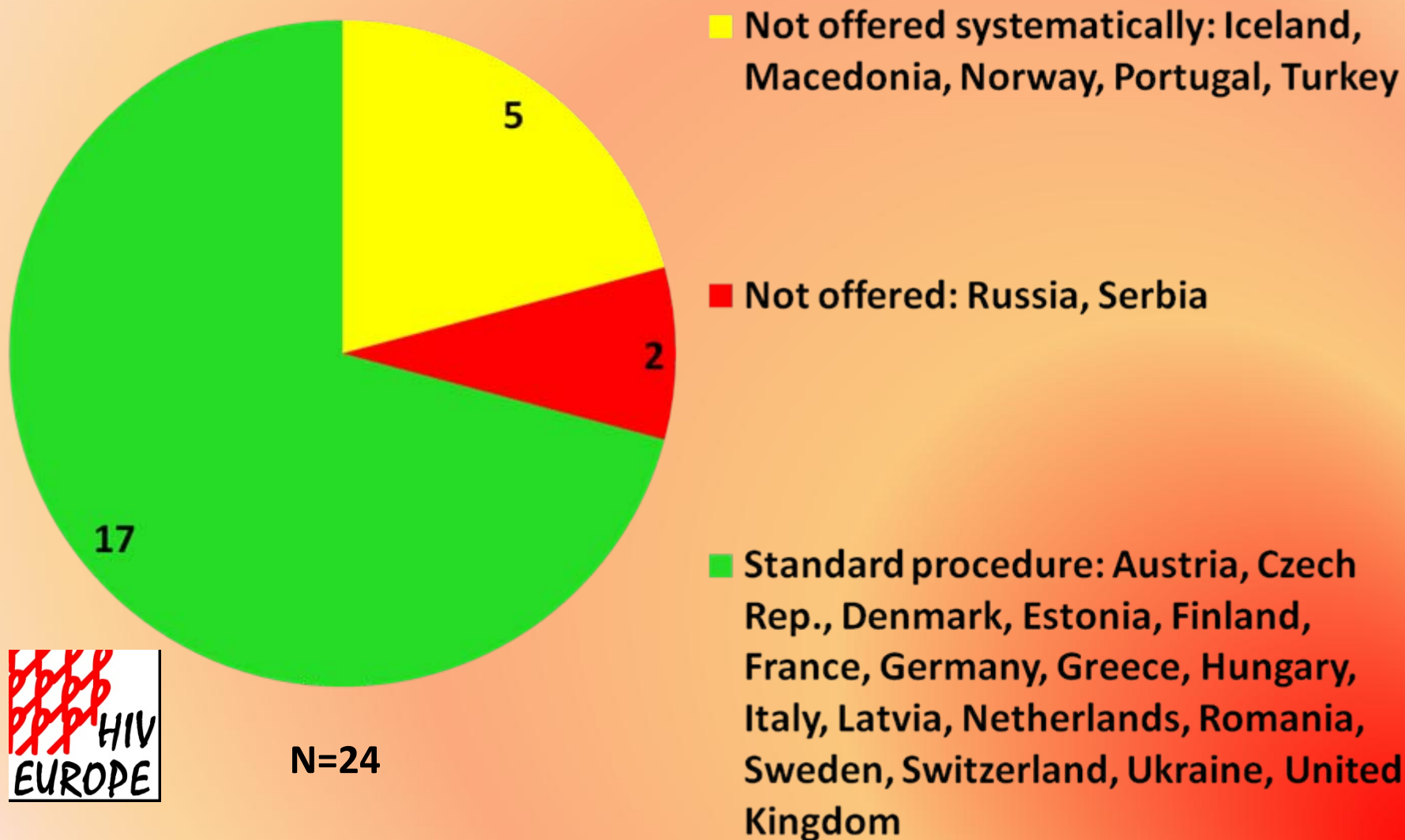
I 1 - If a man with HIV has problems with erection, will he then be offered erection enhancing medication to the same extent as other men?



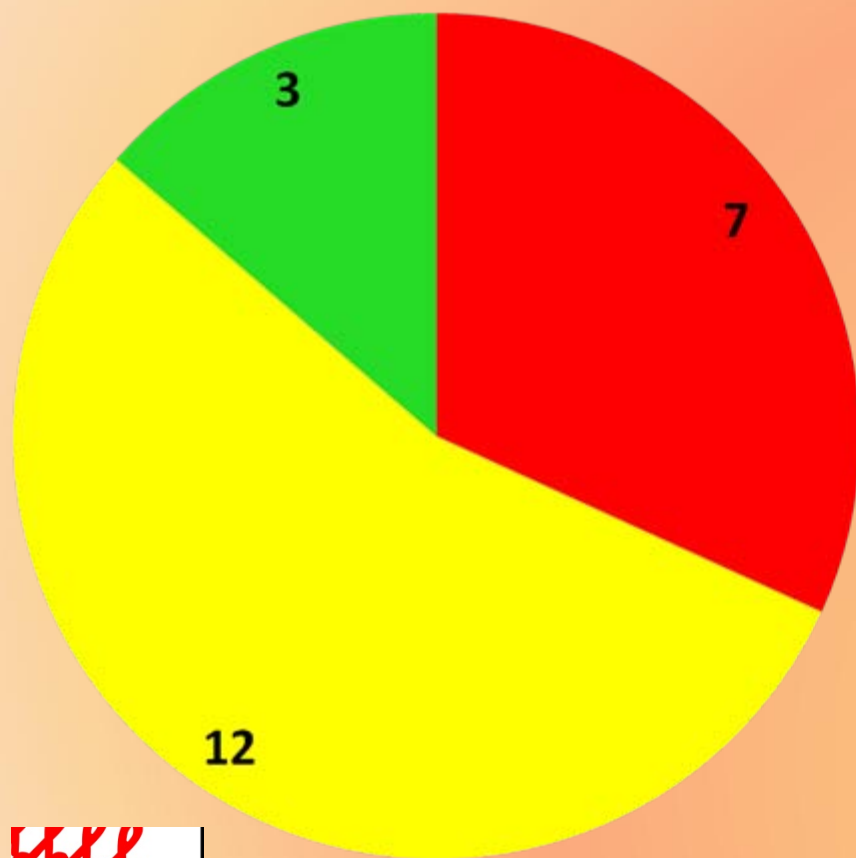
I 2 - Is psychosexual or other psychological assistance offered to people with HIV to the same extent as they are offered to other people?
