### **Steps to Develop an M&E Plan**

- 1. What is the goal of the program
- 2. Identify key indicators for the goal/each element of the goal
- 3. Document baseline level for each indicator
- 4. Set 5 year target for each indicator
- 5. For each indicator/target identify where data will come from; how often it will be collected/reported; who is responsible for what



### What is the goal of the program?

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to reduce the spread of the HIV/AIDS epidemic in country X; to reduce vulnerability of the most vulnerable groups and to strengthen their response to the epidemic; to improve living conditions of people living with HIV/AIDS and to strengthen the national capacity to respond effectively to HIV/AIDS

### 4 elements

- Low prevalence biologic
- Reduce vulnerability, i.e. risk behavior behavioral
- Provide treatment, care and support for PLWHAs?
- Strengthen national capacity is this really part of goal

### What is the goal of the program?

To reduce HIV prevalence in country X by reducing risk behavior among vulnerable groups and to provide treatment, care and support for PLWHAs

# Identify key indicators for the goal/each element of the goal

Biologic surveillance data – HIV prevalence rates among vulnerable groups

Behavioral surveillance data – UNGASS has recommended indicators – focus on vulnerable groups

Treatment, care and support

- Percentage of adults on treatment who increase their weight by at least 10% 6 months after initiation of antiretroviral treatment
- Percentage of people remaining on treatment at 6, 12, and 24 months
- Percentage of people still alive at 6, 12, and 24 months after initiation of antiretroviral treatment



## What is the current level for each of these indicators? (Baseline)

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Many countries find this difficult

Main reason is absence of baseline data – particularly among the most vulnerable groups

If baseline data is absent – a key priority is to collect this

Without baseline information, you can NOT set realistic targets, for example baseline unknown: target reduction of 25% on baseline. What does this mean?



## What do you want this level to be in 5 years (Target)?

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#### Issues

- Absolute (e.g. reduction to) rather than relative (e.g. reduction by). For example, if the baseline is 50% and the relative target is to reduce by 10%. What is the absolute target?
- When using percentages need clarity over denominator and numerator



### For each indicator:

- Where will you get the data from?
- How often will this data be collected/ reported?
- Who will be responsible for what?
- Workload/Priority?

### **Steps to Develop an M&E Plan**

- 6. Identify key service delivery/implementation areas
- 7. Develop key indicators for each service delivery area
- 8. Document baseline level for each indicator
- 9. Set annual targets for each indicator
- 10. For each indicator/target identify where data will come from; how often it will be collected/reported; who is responsible for what



## What are the key implementation/service delivery areas?

## Identify key indicators for each service delivery/implementation area

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At least 1 in each area. Maximum of 4.

- Number of people reached
- Number of service delivery points established or enhanced
- Number of service deliverers trained

For example:

- Number of people receiving VCT
- Number of centers offering VCT
- Number of health and other staff trained in VCT



## What is the current level for each of these indicators? (Baseline)

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- Absolute numbers rather than percentages
- If you use percentages specify numerator and denominator
- Unique individuals or contacts/person times
- Baselines should include <u>ALL</u> activities in a country, not only those funded by a particular donor

- Cumulative versus annual
- Include or exclude baselines?
- Are targets realistic?
