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**General objectives**

1. To prevent new HBV, HCV and HIV/AIDS infections, especially among young people aged 15-24.
2. To identify and disseminate good practices, contents and tools about HBV, HCV and HIV training programmes and prevention campaigns aiming to help all stakeholders in the EU, particularly in IT, RO, EL, SI, PL, CZ, BG, HU, CY, MT and IT.
3. To organise training courses for health care staff in treatment and support services and for parents to become more aware and to be able to give detailed information to children.
4. To organise prevention campaigns in young people meeting venues.
5. To distribute the prevention material also among people working with youth in conditions that could be at risk of infection as dentists, tattoos artists, beauticians and hairdressers.

**Methods and means**

Identification of best practices among EU countries in the fight against HBV, HCV and HIV/AIDS will aim to identify innovative strategies to promote safer sex among youth, including those at higher risk. Multilingual and multimodal digital platform will be set up containing all the references about the health/education trainers and providing an e-learning environment for HBV, HCV and HIV education using innovative pedagogical approaches and new online learning and training methods. Finally, a prevention campaign will be organised in several meeting venues attended by young people (discos, pubs, bars and sport centres) to raise awareness about HBV, HCV and HIV/AIDS risk of infection.

**Expected outcomes**

1. Identification of best practices among H-CUBE project partner countries in the fight against HBV, HCV and HIV/AIDS to promote safer sex among youth, including those at higher risk.
2. Transfer of good practices in the new EU member states, to adapt the methodology of the local actors working in the fight of HBV, HCV and HIV/AIDS to the identified good practices and to transfer the know-how of the most experienced partners creating a multiplier effect.
3. A training course for operators of the partners about how to use the digital platform that will be organised during the first project meeting once the platform will be ready to work.
4. E-learning training courses carried out by means of the following activities: a. Identification of all the EU relevant training programmes concerning HBV, HCV and HIV and good practices; b. Organisation of the courses; c. Publication of a manual containing the training materials (available in digital version).
5. European prevention campaign in several meeting venues attended by young people taking into account the lifestyles, behaviours, cultures and religious differences of each participating country.

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
