The INTEGRATE Joint Action seeks to increase integrated early diagnosis and linkage to prevention and care of HIV, viral hepatitis, TB and STIs in EU Member States by 2020. Integrate offers a platform to disseminate and exchange best practices among Member States and facilitate the discussions on innovations and emerging issues within these four diseases. Existing tools for prevention, testing and linkage to care for HIV, viral hepatitis, TB and STIs will be evaluated, adapted, extended and implemented for one or more of the four diseases in selected pilot countries. It is a shared European effort that aspires to extend beyond the partners to create important synergies across European stakeholders, projects and initiatives.


EU Joint Action on integrating prevention, testing and linkage to care strategies across HIV, viral hepatitis, TB and STIs in Europe

The INTEGRATE Joint Action seeks to improve the understanding and implement integrated activities related to early diagnosis of HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus), Hep (viral hepatitis), TB (Tuberculosis) and STIs (Sexually Transmitted Infections) and linkage to prevention and care in Europe.

The four disease areas share common social and health determinants affecting the same vulnerable populations, are treatable and create unnecessary suffering of patients. INTEGRATE aspires to implement a multidimensional approach that will reduce the public health burden and determine the optimal profile of interventions to be implemented.

Objectives

- Support collaborative implementation of the Joint Action activities through timely reporting, dissemination and evaluation.
- Support national institutions in reviewing and revising policies and action plans to include integrated activities related to early diagnosis & prevention of the four diseases.
- Improve the monitoring & evaluation of these activities and assist in the integration of data into national surveillance and M&E (Monitoring & Evaluation) systems.
- Improve the use of ICT (Information and Communication Technologies) tools and partner notification for prevention by 2020.
- Ensure better preparedness of healthcare professionals, civil society organizations and public health institutions through training and knowledge sharing on the integration of diagnosis and linkage to care for HIV, viral hepatitis, TB and STIs.



INTEGRATE will map and utilize existing effective tools that were developed to reduce transmission, optimize early diagnosis and linkage to care in one or more disease areas. Through a peer-review process, tools that are complementary for other diseases will be identified and evaluated.

INTEGRATE will provide a platform to facilitate the review of these tools and their cross-linking abilities, evaluate the need for adaptation or further innovation and employ multidimensional approaches to identify and implement the optimal profile for linkage to care.

The tools will be piloted in 12 of the partner countries and regional workshops will be held in Poland, Italy and Estonia to discuss the pilots as well as the WP topics in the regional contexts.

In 2019 INTEGRATE will hold a conference in conjunction with the European HEPHIV Conference in Romania.
