- support health promotion and disease prevention,
- contribute to effectiveness, accessibility and resilience of health systems,
- make healthcare safer,
- reduce health inequalities,
- protect citizens from cross-border health threats,
- and support EU health legislation.

- Implementation under responsibility of DG SANTE and under authority of Commissioner responsible for Health
- Direct management
- Rules of the Financial Regulation will apply

- Health Strand develops and tests new approaches and then ESF shared management instruments fund the rolling out
- Possibility to consult the National Health Authorities on other health-supporting investments within ESF+ and other programmes


