## **Call for applications to the AIDS Action Europe Steering Committee**

AIDS Action Europe opens the call for the election of new members of the Steering Committee. There are currently five vacancies in the Steering Committee for a three-year term of 2023 – 2025, starting on 01 January 2023.

### In order to apply, you need to meet the following criteria:

- be individually committed to coordinated NGO action and the AIDS Action Europe mission;
- be affiliated with and selected as a representative of an organization that is a member of AIDS Action Europe *and* actively participates in the network
- have a good working knowledge of English.

#### The candidates should also:

- have global knowledge about the main policies, trends, issues, and activities in their respective geographical sub-region;
- o have good networking skills and contacts with networks, NGOs, and possible sponsors.

Steering Committee members attend on a personal title and in recognition of their personal expertise and secondly as a representative of the nominating AIDS Action Europe member organization.

All interested AAE Member organisations can nominate **one** representative to the Steering Committee. The new Steering Committee members will be elected by the membership of AIDS Action Europe.


#### How to apply

- An application form
- A letter of support from the AIDS Action Europe Member organisation nominating the candidate
- A letter of recommendation from another AAE member organization (preferably from the country or the region of the applicant)

All documents should be submitted in English. Please keep in mind that your documents will be accessible to the members of the Network who registered to vote.

The Steering Committee of AIDS Action Europe should be balanced in terms of HIV status, gender, geographic representation, thematic diversity and key populations.
