

Call for Interest - Training of Trainers on Offering and Adapting Existing Harm Reduction Services for ChemSex Users

Dear AAE Member Organisations,

We are excited to announce an upcoming **Training of Trainers (ToT) on Offering and Adapting Existing Harm Reduction Services for ChemSex Users**. The training will be based on the "Harm Reduction in the Context of ChemSex: an AIDS Action Europe Training Manual", which has been recently developed by Antonios Poulios in cooperation with AIDS Action Europe.

The training will take place in Berlin for a duration of **3 days in September (13-15.09**). Travel expenses, including flights, local transport costs, accommodation, and meals for the participants will be covered.

This ToT aims to build and strengthen the capacity of AAE member organisations providing harm reduction services for people who use drugs or other services for GBMSM community, who are willing to adapt their existing service to the needs of chemsex users and make them more inclusive and responsive to the needs of the GBMSM community, or have harm reduction services for chemsex users.

We are inviting qualified individuals to apply for this training opportunity.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants must represent an organisation, which is an AAE member organisation and is registered and based in one of the EU countries, Iceland, Norway, Ukraine, or Moldova.¹
- Applicants must represent an organisation that has solid experience in the provision of harm reduction services, and/or sexual health services and other health services to key populations.
- Applicants' organisation should provide services for chemsex users or be willing to provide or adjust their existing harm reduction services for chemsex users.
- Applicants must have experience as a trainer/presenter and be willing to deliver further training in their organisation and/or in their country based on this ToT.
- Applicants must have a good level of English, as the training will be conducted in English.

Required Documents

- CV
- Cover letter explaining your motivation, related experience, and interest in this training. Please also explain how you are planning to transfer the knowledge in your work or the work of your organisation (and/or other organisations in the country).
- Letter confirming that you represent and is delegated by your organisation to attend the training.
