SGPP

- Formal Commission expert group set up in 2018, 27 Member States, Norway and Iceland; other Commission services, agencies and the European Investment Bank: Meetings of health ministries and joint meetings of health and research ministries
- Member States advise the Commission on activities related to non-communicable diseases
- Open to all Commission services as a platform for policy advice
- Sub-groups on proton therapy centres and planned on cancer (cancer mission and the Europe Beating Cancer Plan)
- Support to the transfer and scaling up in the Member States of best practices and research results supported via EU funds

SGPP priorities

- Survey to define the priorities for next best practice transfers – 2021 and 2022
- AMR, cancer, access and availability of medicines, prevention of non-communicable diseases
- Best practice portal the key tool for submitting practice proposals

Best practice portal and calls

- Calls for practices
 - Best practice evaluation criteria being revised: broader scope to cover vaccination
 - Joint research centre leads the evaluation
 - Best practices proposed for the SGPP
 - Member States rank the ones they want to transfer to national setting
 - Implementation supported through EU programmes (EU4Health)
