- Finnish Red Cross offers test in 4 sites once a week
- Services for drug users
- A-clinic foundation has one year Street project: testing HepC and HIV on the streets



- Mobile unit: May, June (HelsinkiPride) and August
- Park areas, Gay Sauna, Helsinki Pride, Highway resting area
- Peer staff (msm) and peer voluntary workers doing out reach
- HelsinkiPride park testing test result by SMS on following Monday


533 HIV rapid tests

Test Clients

- Sex with men only: 83% of test clients at the office and 92% in the mobile unit
- Sex with both men and women:
 13% of test clients at the office and
 7% in the mobile unit
- Unprotected anal sex: 51% of test clients at the office and 73% in the mobile unit
- Testing at the office reached more men with immigrant background (16% vs 5%) and travellers (14% vs 5%) than the mobile unit




Positive Test Results

Pro-tukipiste

- 2015: 275 HIV-tests (in Helsinki and Tampere)
- Visits to health care professionals 1022 (nurse and doctor)
- Drop in center visits 3681
- Always counselling, condoms, lubricants and HIV tests and other tests are offered



Hiv-tests and counselling by people living with HIV

- Starting on HIV-testing week
- The rapid test (60 sec) is taken by a person living with HIV so that the person knows this
- 5 persons trained
 - 2 women and 3 men, 2 of them are nurses
- In cooperation with HIV Center and Sex workers organisation
 - Trying to reach most at risk populations
