The EU Civil Society Forum on HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis and viral hepatitis is an advisory body supported by the European Commission to facilitate the involvement of civil society in policy and programme making. It brings together 40 member national organisations and regional networks. The CSF is currently coordinated by AIDS Action Europe; Correlation European Harm Reduction Network; Eurasian Harm Reduction Association; European AIDS Treatment Group; TB Europe Coalition / Global Health Advocates.

The CSF member organisations and community groups from all over the region have been invited to present their activities, in particular, when it comes to government and NGO collaboration at national and European level, as well as other advocacy activities. This booth will provide knowledge about the situation in the European region, including key populations, and facilitate networking between countries, regions and key populations. The booth will expose conference participants to the stories of the epidemic in Europe, what remains to be done and innovative ways in which civil society intervenes. It will share good practice examples and information across sectors for better results in the response to the epidemic in WHO's European region. It aims to encourage stronger networking between stakeholders across the region and across sectors, and to share advocacy tools to improve the situation of key affected populations across the region.
